

Mannford HS Homecoming Parade Float Regulations and Registration

Homecoming Parade will be on September 22nd, 2023 at **2:10 p.m.** Float staging will begin on Hinton and continue down Greenwood.

All floats must be 55 ft. or less in order to participate in the parade and an adult (21+ years old) with a valid and current driver's license with a clean driving record must drive all vehicles and pull all trailers in the parade.

Floats must fit the Mannford Homecoming Theme **"Movie Madness"**.

Floats with any inappropriate or profane decorations, signs, or objects will be subject to immediate dismissal from the parade with no warning.

Floats must comply with a pre-parade inspection by a float inspector to check for adherence to homecoming theme. Floats will also be checked to ensure that the brake lights on the vehicles and trailers are working properly. Floats not in compliance are subject to immediate dismissal from the parade.

Each float is responsible for the safety of their own passengers. Mannford HS makes no guarantee of safety while participating in the Homecoming Parade. **Passengers may not throw candy or treats from their float.** Participates may walk and distribute candy or treats directly to students.
